- 9-12 Minor Trauma Use local guidelines/protocols
 6-8 Potentially Life Threatening, Suggests need for Pediatric Trauma Center
 0-5 Life Threatening, Need for Pediatric Trauma Center
 <0 Usually Fatal Transport to Nearest Facility

Revised Adult Trauma Score

A. Respiratory Rate

Value	Points
0	= 0
1-5	= 1
6-9	= 2
>29	= 3
10-29	= 4

B. Systolic Blood Pressure

Value	Points
0	= 0
1-49	= 1
50-75	= 2
76-89	= 3
>89	= 4

C. Glasgow Coma Scale

1. Eye Opening

Spontaneous	— 4
To Voice	— 3
To Pain	— 2
None	— 1

3. Motor Response

Obey Commands	— 6
Purposeful Movement (pain)	— 5
Withdraw (pain)	— 4
Flexion (pain)	— 3
Extension (pain)	— 2
None	— 1

2. Adult Verbal Response

Orientated	— 5
Confused	— 4
Inappropriate Words	— 3
Incomprehensible Words	— 2
None	— 1

2. Infant & Toddler Verbal Response

Smiles, oriented to sounds, follows objects, interacts	— 5
Cries but consolable, inappropriate interactions	— 4
Inconsistently inconsolable, moaning	— 3
Inconsolable, agitated	— 2
No verbal response	— 1
