SOP 400 Updates – Scott Bernette reviews the changes to this SOP as suggested by several officers at the last meeting. Several changes will need to be made to comply with the new SPS 330 which takes effect on 10/1/2018. Changes to be presented at next meeting.

Training Division Manual – Several updates handed out. Scott Bernette & John Andersen went through the training manual to show how we are complying with the changes to SPS 330. Training Officers to review manual for any other changes needed by next meeting.

MOG on CO related events - Dan Enestved reviewed how several departments in the area handle CO Calls. Exposure limits, inhalation, and symptoms for CO calls reviewed. Training Officers preferred the layout Township's SOG with a SCBA required for 500 ppm or more. MOG will be reviewed at next meeting.

Near Miss Report – Chuck Smith talked about power line issue that caused the power pole to become energized when the line was pulled out of the transformer on the pole. Josh Rihn talked about a tree in the power lines were personal vehicles under the lines and owners wanting to leave prior to tree being removed from powerline. It was talked about how we should explain the danger of the scene. John Andersen talked about the down cable / phone lines and putting out cones until a service crew could respond. This is not a practice we would for down powerlines for safety reasons.
