- 1. Meeting called to order by Chief Bernette with 10 Officers present.

Chief Bernette reviewed with officer's present about this being a requirement for the Assistant Chief, Training Officers

## 4. New Business:

- A. Update on Over the Road & Vehicle Skill Sheets Station 1 reported that they are almost completed at this time of the members wishing to drive and operate the pumps. They also have several members that only completed the driving requirement as they did not wish to operate the pump at this time. Station 3 reported that they are two-thirds completed at this time. They plan to hold several more training opportunities on normal Wednesday drill nights as well as a Saturday training session too. Station 6 reported that they are about halfway completed at this time. There was a review of why this needs to be complete and why the documentation is required to comply with SPS 330. There was no report given for Station 2 at this time. Completion date is set for October 1st, 2019 per SPS 330. Chief Bernette pointed out that there are several Entry level Driver Operator for members that need this class or want to take it. Members that have not completed their driving and or driving/pumping with documentation turned in by 10/1/2019 will not be authorized to operate District vehicles emergent until completed to comply with SPS 330.
- B. Near Miss Report: No District near misses reported at this time. Mark Roshell talked about several issues with people serving at flaggers controlling work zone traffic that were talked about the County Traffic Safety meeting today. We should be watchful as we are in the road right of way. Cory Jeffers brought up the topic of NARCAN and how Law Enforcement is using it. Also talked about how the general public has been using it prior to EMS getting on scene. Need to very mindful that this patient might be wake when we get on scene and could be in a very different mode from when the call was placed.
